
## Yukon Assembly Instructions for Spicer 60 & 70 Powr Lok Discs & Plates



- 1. To reduce clutch chatter, soak the clutches & discs in Yukon friction modifier overnight (Yukon part # OILADD).
- 2. Install one Clutch Hub onto a Side Gear.
- Place one Friction Plate against the Clutch Ring. It does not matter which side of the Friction Plate faces the Clutch Ring.
- 4. Place one of the Belleville Plates against the Friction Plate with the convex side in. The inner diameter of the Belleville Plate should contact the Friction Plate.
- 5. Place one Friction Plate against the Belleville Plate. Again, it does not matter which side faces the Belleville Plate.
- 6. Repeat steps 4 and 5.
- 7. Repeat steps 2 through 6 for the opposing side gear.
- 8. Install the side gear & clutch assemblies into the case halves one at a time. Hold each case half upside down and push the side gear & clutch assembly up into place. Attempting to drop the side gear & clutch assembly down into a case half that is face up may result in the clutches falling off the side gear.
- 9. Place the top carrier case half into position and torque the carrier case bolts to 45 ft./lbs.
- 10. With the carrier assembly installed into the housing and the differential cover in place, fill the differential with the proper amount of gear oil and a bottle of friction modifier (Yukon part #OILADD).
